# Female social and economic contribution to the Wheatbelt Region 

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## Introduction

This comparative analysis of female data in the Wheatbelt Region was undertaken to examine the extent of the social and economic contribution females make to the region, sub regions and shires. The analysis also considered changes in contributions from females between 2011 and 2021. The aim was also to illustrate potential needs in some locations such as childcare that may require attention to support females as they contribute to their communities, shires and the Wheatbelt as a whole.

## Executive summary

The analysis primarily looked at the female 15-74 years age group in comparison to the male 15-74 years age group as according to the Census data, these demographics provided the core contributions in terms of labour force, work force, volunteering and providing unpaid assistance in their shires. In addition, the 75 and over age group was included in the analysis in relation to volunteering and providing unpaid assistance due to the understanding that this population is on an increasing trend in the region.

For the purposes of this review, volunteering is considered to be unpaid work for an organizational group and unpaid assistance is considered to be caring for those with a disability, health condition or aged persons.

Key economic takeaways for the region as whole were;

- Both the female and male 15-74 years population had increase by 4\% between 2011 and 2021 but females continued to comprise $48 \%$ of the population.
- The female 15-74 years labour force had increased from 44\% of the labour force to 46\% between 2011 and 2021 with females registering a $3 \%$ increase within their gender and the males a $6 \%$ decrease.
- $37 \%$ of females in the labour force had dependent children between the age of $0-12$ years and $11 \%$ had dependent children between 0-4 years. Just 1\% of males in the labour force had dependent children between 0-12 years.
- Overall female participation in the eight occupation categories had increased from 44\% to 47\% between 2011 and 2021.
- In terms of the managers and professional occupations females had recorded a 4\% decrease and 7\% increase respectively while males had recorded a $16 \%$ and $4 \%$ decrease in the respective occupations.

Of note was the attainment of post school tertiary qualifications by females in the region in terms of university degrees. Almost a quarter (24\%) of 15-74 year old females across the region had attained a Post Graduate, Graduate Certificate/Diploma, Bachelor, or Advanced Diploma/ Diploma level qualification compared to $11 \%$ of males. Alternately, $27 \%$ of $15-74$ year old males had attained a Certificate Level qualification compared to $18 \%$ of females.

But these outcomes should be considered in context which is there are a far greater number of females employed in education and health which mostly require a university level qualification and a far greater number of males employed in industry sectors that require Certificate Level qualifications. A key point is that 42\% of 15-74 year old females and $38 \%$ of males in the region have attained post school qualifications.

In turn results from the social analysis showed that in 2021 females 15 years and over were continuing to volunteer more than the males at a rate of $55 \%$ to $45 \%$ respectively but that the overall rate of volunteering had dropped from $30 \%$ in 2011 to $24 \%$ in 2021. This decrease could be attributed to the following changes between 2011 and 2021.

- The female 15-64 years age group registered a $23 \%$ decrease and the males a $35 \%$ decrease.
- The female 65 and over age group registered a $33 \%$ increase and the males a $34 \%$ increase, however these increases were not enough to offset the decreases in the 15-64 age group.

Correspondingly, while the overall level of provision unpaid assistance remained proportionality the same at $11 \%$ between 2011 and 2021 and females continued to provide unpaid assistance at a higher rate than males (56\% compared to 44\%), the number of males providing unpaid assistance rose by $16 \%$ between 2011 and 2021.

In conclusion, the analysis showed that while females made up $48 \%$ of the $15-74$ years population in 2021 their participation in the labour force had risen $46 \%$ and in the work force $47 \%$ up from $44 \%$ respectively and there had been a $7 \%$ increase in the number of female professionals. Of note is that while more females entered the labour force and work force it appeared that males, despite the same increase in the 15-74 years age group were not. Additionally, females were more likely than males to volunteer and provide unpaid assistance although in both cases the levels of contribution had decreased between 2011 and 2021.

These responses suggest that there may be a change in the female dynamics in the region. With more females remaining or entering the work force including the $37 \%$ with dependent children between 0 and 12 years, there could be less time available for them to volunteer or provide unpaid assistance. While the economy and particularly the availability of the pool of local labour force may alleviate some level of labour force demand it may have more negative repercussions for the volunteering sector if the traditional model of higher female volunteerism than male continues without some balancing adjustments.

## Analysis methodology and explanatory notes

The approach to this analysis was to only compare male and female 15 years and over Census data from 2011 and 2021. The comparison was to examine changes between the genders over the 10 year period in respect to the 15 to 74 years population numbers, labour force and participation in the various occupations. In regard to the social aspects of the analysis, the age demographics were extended to the 65-84 and 85 years and over age groups.

Comparisons between the genders between 2011 and 2012 were made using Census data from both dates in the following categories.

- Population
- Labour force
- Labour force status by sex of parents by age of dependent children for couple families (was only introduced in 2021 Census)
- Labour force status by sex of parent by age of dependent children for one parent families (was only introduced in 2021 Census) with 0-12 and 0-4 year old children
- Occupation by age by sex
- Post school education attainment
- Voluntary work for an organisation or group by age by sex
- Unpaid assistance to a person with a disability, health condition or due to old age by age by sex (ABS, 2021 \& 2011. Census of Population and Housing, General Community Profiles)

Comparative analysis of the 15-74 years population and labour force was undertaken to ascertain what changes in the population numbers had had on labour force numbers. That was if changes in the population numbers were closely or less closely correlated with changes in the labour force.

Although it was not possible to compare the labour force status by sex of parent of dependent children in the 2021 Census with the 2011 Census as it was a new inclusion in the 2021 Census, it was examined in the analysis with the focus being on dependent children aged between 0-12 years and 0-4 years. These age categories were chosen as they represented children of high dependence (0-4 years) and children that needed a level of care and supervision before and after school.

The analysis of the changes in the 15-74 year old populations also provided a baseline for measuring the levels of volunteering and providing unpaid assistance in the 15-74 year old age groups.

Occupation by age and sex looked at possible changes in female and male representation across the eight categories of occupations with particular attention to the Managers and Professionals occupation. These two occupations were of interest due to a number of factors. The first was that both occupations were close proxy indicators of changes in business numbers and delivery of professional services between 2021 and 2011. The second factor was if there were changes in the number of female managers and professionals. The third factor was that managers and professionals were an important element of the social networks that underpinned the social capital in communities ${ }^{1}$ which in turn is a critical component in communities ongoing sustainability or vulnerability.

Finally, analysis of volunteering and unpaid assistance was conducted as the earlier analyses showed that 15-74 year old female participation in the labour force had increased across most LGs and females had provided a greater proportion of volunteering and provision of unpaid assistance than males. The aim was to measure changes in the levels of volunteering and provision of unpaid assistance of this age group of females and males. The 65 and over age group was included in the analysis as this population had increased markedly between 2011 and 2021 and the aim was to see if there had also been changes in the rates of volunteerism and provision of unpaid assistance.
